Our ministry partners, donors and the global MegaVoice team have trusted the Lord's lovingkindness for good things, and now a million MegaVoice audio Bibles have been distributed - Hallelujah! We rejoice!

Genesis of the MegaVoice Team - 1989

MegaVoice really began moving forward 25 years ago in Manila at the Lausanne II: International Congress on World Evangelization. It was during that event that Tom Treseder, then State Director of the Bible Society in Australia (NSW), spent days meeting with American engineer, Ken Crowell. Both were like-minded men and united in their desire to reach billions of non-reading people using audio Scriptures.

Tom related to Ken his incredible frustration with the serious limitations of cassette tape player technology. The very media which had taken the western church by storm in the 70's and 80's had been adopted by agencies in their work - but cassette players proved to be no match for harsh field environments.

And there were other drawbacks to using tape. A whopping 40 audio cassettes were required to playback a single Bible, assuming of course that you could get a tape to play at all. In tropical climates tapes turned into a kind of elastic mess. In arid places across the 10/40

Window, playback heads and gears were ground to bits by invading sand. There had to be a better way - a better technology - to reach the billions who simply could not read the

Tom showed Ken a sketch of his proposed solar-powered audio Bible along with a long list of desired features for the envisioned device. He then told him how Mazda cars told their drivers, Shut the door! Hearing those talking Mazda car warnings really lit a fire under Tom - something radically new could be made! The Mazda audio messages were stored on 10 second memory chips. Tom hoped that if Ken could somehow combine two chips, maybe they could get twenty seconds of audio.
